## HISTORY

Muthigi-ini factory was established in 1968 and rests on a 7 acres piece of land serving Cieni, Gaciongo, Kiaragana and Kariko Villages. Currently it is affiliated to Rwama Farmers' Cooperative Society Ltd. Its membership currently stands at 2,000. is selectively handpicked and delivered to the wet mill the same day. Red, ripe cherries are separated from under-ripes, over-ripes and foreign matter and the wet mill processing utilizes clean river water that's later re-circulated before it is disposed of in seepage pits. Before the coffee is delivered to the dry mill for secondary processing, it's dried in the sun on traditional raised beds.
