Mbinga district is the most Southerly coffee producing area in Tanzania. The region produces 6 -14,000 metric tonnes of arabica green beans a year and less than half is fully washed. Several projects are encouraging smallholders to sell their cherries to CPUs in order to produce better coffee which then enables them to earn more money.
