Arabica coffee from the Wayanad Social Service Society (WSSS) in Kerala, India, offers a unique flavor shaped by its altitude, climate, and sustainable practices. WSSS supports smallholder farmers and promotes organic farming, with beans often grown in shaded areas to protect biodiversity.

The Wayanad Organic Agricultural Development Society (Organic Wayanad) unites over 400 organic farmers who cultivate a diverse range of crops, including coffee, spices, fruits, and vegetables using zero-budget farming techniques. They apply local cow manure and vermicompost, especially at the start of the southwest monsoon. Organic Wayanad also features a centralized, eco-friendly coffee processing system that is continually improved through knowledge sharing and support
